Day 1. Wednesday 10 March 2027

HOME PORT – BAROSSA VALLEY | D

Let's begin our journey as we depart our home port and board our flight to Adelaide. Our Tour Host will travel from Mackay and meet us either at Mackay Airport, in transit at Brisbane Airport or upon arrival in Adelaide.

After breakfast, we'll embark on a full-day tour exploring the many delights of the Barossa Valley, one of Australia's most celebrated wine regions.

Today promises a feast for the senses as we sample some of the finest local wines, meet passionate winemakers, and enjoy a leisurely two-course lunch at a picturesque winery. Highlights include a guided tour and tasting at the historic Chateau Tanunda, rich in heritage and charm, followed by a visit to Maggie Beer's Farm Shop to browse and buy gourmet local treats.

This evening is yours to relax or further explore the beauty and flavours of the Barossa at your own pace.

Day 3. Friday 12 March 2027

BAROSSA VALLEY - MANNUM, EMBARK CRUISE | B D

Today, we will begin with a relaxed breakfast and enjoy a leisurely morning before departing for the charming riverside town of Mannum to embark on our next venture.

Along the way, we'll stop for lunch at a local eatery (at your own expense), offering a chance to stretch your legs and take in the scenery.

Upon arrival in Mannum we will board the Murray Princess as we begin our 7 night Upper Murraylands Cruise along the mighty Murray River. Our cruise departs historic Mannum, the birthplace of the Murray River trade and communication. We will travel upriver while we enjoy a welcome dinner with our group plus other fellow Murray Princess guests.

As we begin our cruise along its tranquil waters, we will be surrounded by towering sandstone cliffs, lush riverbanks, and abundant birdlife. The journey takes us deep into the heart of the outback, with opportunities to explore historic riverside towns and learn about the river's fascinating heritage. Onboard, enjoy warm hospitality, comfortable accommodation, and hearty cuisine inspired by local flavours. A Murray River cruise aboard the Murray Princess is a relaxing and unique way to experience one of Australia's greatest waterways.

As we cruise under floodlight to our overnight mooring at Caurnamont, we may see nocturnal wildlife on the riverbank. Watch for kangaroos, hairy-nosed wombats, tortoises, egrets and many other species. Our on-board entertainer provides music for the night owls.

Day 4. Saturday 13 March 2027

MURRAY RIVER CRUISE | B L D

Daybreak and it's time for the keen photographers to be out to capture the special light and the morning movement of wildlife. This morning, your discovery vessel awaits for a wildlife tour. Travelling in small, personalised groups, we explore the maze of the river and the birdlife is amazing. Watch for darters, herons and egrets feeding along the river's muddy edges.

For those who choose to stay on-board, you may wish to partake in a game of bocce or compete in the fishing challenge before we cruise upriver past Walker Flat and Sugar Shack Conservation Park.

Day 5. Sunday 14 March 2027

MURRAY RIVER CRUISE | B L D

Continue cruising upriver this morning as we enjoy breakfast and pass through one of 13 locks which maintain the flow and levels of the river's water. This morning, enjoy some free time and in the afternoon join in the fun playing a few games of bingo.

Late afternoon we will secure the vessel at Morgan and after dinner join the 'Morgan by Night' historic walk of the town.

Day 6. Monday 15 March 2027

MURRAY RIVER CRUISE | B L D

Today we are transferred by coach to the Riverland town of Renmark. Visit the Renmark Paringa Community Museum and experience the bygone time, with interactive displays that are always evolving.

Enjoy a casual riverside lunch at the heritage-listed Hotel Renmark, the first community-owned hotel in the British Empire. After lunch you can wander through the Hotel Museum and discover the many fascinating moments from its storied past.

Finish the afternoon with a behind-the-scenes tour at 23rd Street Distillery, with free time to enjoy one of their signature cocktails (own expense).

Return by coach to Morgan where we will re-board the Murray Princess and continue our journey upriver, securing for the night at the 326km mark of the Murray River.

Day 7. Tuesday 16 March 2027

MURRAY RIVER CRUISE | B L D

After breakfast, we continue upriver to our turnaround point, picturesque Hogwash Bend.

Enjoy a leisurely lunch as we cruise downriver towards Morgan. Join a guided walk of the township and the Morgan Living History Museum, before continuing to our mooring at Blanchetown.

Visit Burk Salter Boutique Winery and enjoy wine tasting at the cellar door, which is fitted out with beautiful red gum bars.

After dinner, join us for all the fun and excitement, and participate in our "Murray River Cup".

Day 8. Wednesday 17 March 2027

MURRAY RIVER CRUISE | B L D

After breakfast cruise to picturesque Swan Reach. The town was first settled in the 1850s and was originally the largest of five sheep and cattle stations in the area and is now home to native flower and fruit growers. The original Swan Reach homestead is now the Swan Reach Hotel where you can enjoy an ale or cappuccino overlooking the Murray River (additional cost). Join a walking tour and visit the Swan Reach Museum (gold coin donation at entry), where local stories and artefacts bring the river's pioneering past to life.

Cruise downriver after lunch and take in the tranquillity as the landscape slides by. The ever-changing vistas of ochre cliffs, red gums, and reflections on the water make this one of the most relaxing parts of the journey.

When we arrive at Sunnydale, it's all ashore for the Woolshed Show as we recreate typical Australian woolshed history. Later we visit the Native Wildlife Shelter where some of South Australia's most interesting native animals are cared for. And then of course, there is the great Aussie Barbecue – cooked and served in a bush setting on the banks of the mighty Murray River. Share stories with fellow travellers under a canopy of stars, accompanied by the sounds of the bush.

InterContinental Adelaide

This evening, we have the option to book an optional Sunnydale Nocturnal Tour. Optional tours are an additional cost and can only be prebooked once onboard the ship. For those who join, it's a chance to experience the Murray under moonlight, spotting nocturnal wildlife and discovering a whole new side of the river environment.

Day 9. Thursday 18 March 2027

MURRAY RIVER CRUISE | B L D

This morning enjoy a special Sunnydale Bush Tucker Breakfast. Alternatively you could choose to do a bush walk with the Captain. Afterwards we slowly cruise downriver past magnificent cliffs scoured by the river over millions of years. Watch as the colours of the sandstone shift with the light, creating a breathtaking backdrop for your morning on the water.

We reach Ngaut Ngaut Conservation Park, one of Australia's most significant archaeological sites, for a step back in time – tens of thousands of years – for a guided boardwalk tour to view ancient rock carvings and to learn about Aboriginal history in the area. This cultural experience offers a rare opportunity to connect with the stories, traditions, and deep spiritual significance of the river to the Nganguraku people. We return to the vessel to cruise downriver to Younghusband. Along the way, adventure seekers can also take a scenic tender boat ride to take in the views from a different perspective. As the afternoon unfolds, enjoy the peaceful atmosphere from the sun deck, camera in hand, capturing the wildlife and landscapes that make the Murray so unique.

Tonight, join your fellow passengers for a delicious final night dinner and enjoy the evening entertainment. Celebrate new friendships, share highlights of your journey, and toast to an unforgettable experience on the mighty Murray River.

Day 10. Friday 19 March 2027

MANNUM - ADELAIDE | DISEMBARK CRUISE | B D

We leave Younghusband and head back to Mannum. After breakfast we reluctantly say farewell as we arrive at the

Mannum Wharf and disembark the Murray Princess. We will then make our way via coach to the heart of Adelaide and check in for our final night of the Hosted Journey.

This afternoon, enjoy some well-deserved free time to explore the vibrant city of Adelaide. You might choose to take a leisurely stroll through the lush Adelaide Botanic Gardens, head down to the scenic seaside town of Glenelg by tram or take in a spot of shopping in Rundle Mall.




INTRODUCING *Murray Princess*

The Murray Princess is a true inland paddle wheeler built for the Murray River, with the character and charm of yesteryear. It is the largest inland paddle wheeler in the southern hemisphere. Don't be fooled by most modern-day imitation paddle wheelers where the paddle is often on the side and just for show. The Murray Princess is an authentic paddle wheeler which is propelled by its massive stern wheel. The onboard atmosphere is relaxed and informal by style. The lounge features a majestic view of the paddlewheel in action through the two storey viewing window. The Murray Princess cruises between Mannum, Murray Bridge and Salter's Station along the Murray River.



Travel Insurance:

We recommend Covermore (offered by Helloworld Travel) as, whilst you are away, our Tour Host can communicate directly with our Covermore representative and provide assistance when making claims or enquiries. If you fail to comply with a decision made by a Tour Host, or interfere with the well-being or mobility of the group, the Tour Host may direct you to leave the tour immediately, with no right of refund. We may also elect not to carry you on any future Hosted Journeys. You must, at all times, comply with the laws, customs, foreign exchange and drug regulations of all countries visited.

What's not included:

Items such as (and not limited to) passports, items of a personal nature, beverages, meals and sightseeing not detailed on the itinerary, excess baggage, porterage (unless specified) and travel insurance.
