

Magnificent Madagascar

Madagascar is, above all, a nature destination. While there are certainly interesting man-made facets of the country — including colonial towns, native crafts, and sleepy coastal villages — Madagascar is an ecotraveller's dream. From endless jungles filled with endemic plants, rare birds, and endangered animals, to the white-sand beaches of the Malagasy Islands and limestone karst formations of Ankarana, the island is an explosion of nature at each turn. Cut off from the African mainland 165 million years ago, Madagascar evolved in isolation, leading to many unique and endemic species. The hands-down superstars of this wild performance are the endangered lemur, of which 90 percent of the surviving global population is found only here.

The lush highlands of Madagascar's centre stand in stark contrast to the open savannah of the west and cactus forests that characterise the southern tip, and no island of its size can boast its diversity. Madagascar is home to hundreds of endemic species, including lemurs, chameleons and butterflies, the east African island is a destination for wildlife and nature enthusiasts.

Seychelles, Madagascar & Mauritius

From Victoria on the island of Mahé, you will first sail to La Digue, a veritable picture-postcard of the Seychelles: palm trees, granite rocks, white sand and crystal-clear waters.

Your ship will then set sail for the northern tip of Madagascar. You will be dazzled by the beauty of the deserted beaches and preserved coral reefs of the idyllic islets in the Nosy Hara, Nosy Komba and Nosy Tanikely marine parks, renowned for their fabulous underwater life. In Majunga, you will explore Ankarafantsika National Park, home to numerous bird and lemur species.

After exploring the picturesque and sumptuous city of Belo sur Mer, Le Champlain will then sail towards the wild expanses of the UNESCO Biosphere Reserves in the south-west of Madagascar. Near the mouth of the Onilahu River, Tulear enjoys an exceptional flora that will delight lovers of botany.

Along the immense beaches edged with dunes in Sarodrano, you will experience an exceptional encounter with one of the planet's last "sea nomad" people, the Vezo. You will discover their fishing villages and ancestral maritime know-how.

Out at sea await turquoise waters, the magnificent coral reefs and the natural pools of Nosy Ve, an islet of white sand that shelters a large colony of red-tailed tropic birds.

After calling at Pointe des Galets on La Réunion island, Le Champlain will reach Port Louis in Mauritius, where this unforgettable cruise will draw to an end.

DAY 1. Thu 2 January 2025 HOME PORT - IN TRANSIT

Let's begin our journey as we depart our home port and fly to the Seychelles. Our Tour Host will travel from Mackay and meet us either in transit, or on arrival in the Seychelles.

DAY 2. Fri 3 January 2025 **ARRIVE MAHE, SEYCHELLES**

Today we will arrive in Mahé, Seychelles. We will be met on arrival and transferred to our accommodation. This afternoon we will have some time to settle in before we enjoy a welcome dinner to get to know our fellow travellers.

DAY 3. Sat 4 January 2025 MAHE - EMBARK CRUISE

Discover Mahé, the main island of the Seychelles and also the largest of the archipelago, home to the capital, Victoria. Mahé has almost 70 beaches of fine sand, framed by the emblematic granite rocks, and whose crystal clear waters are renowned for their rich underwater life. The island is also famous for its splendid mountain panoramas accessible on hikes, such as the Morne Seychellois, which is 905 metres high and overlooks the Indian Ocean.

DAY 4. Sun 5 January 2025 LA DIGUE ISLAND

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La Digue Island is a veritable concentration of all the beauty of the Seychelles. This small piece of land that looks like paradise is the third-largest island in the Seychelles, despite its modest size. Turquoise waters just asking you to swim in them, lush vegetation sheltering giant tortoises, beaches of fine sand fringed with coconut trees and surrounded with those emblematic large granite rocks with their pink highlights like at the famous Anse Source d'Argent.

DAY 5 & DAY 6. Mon 6 & Tue 7 January 2025 BLD AT SEA

During our journey at sea, make the most of the many services and activities on board. Take a moment of relaxation or be tempted by the swimming pool and outer deck. Enjoy the conferences or shows on board or do some shopping in the boutique.

DAY 7. Wed 8 January 2025 BLD **NOSY HARA**

Its limestone rock formations rising from the waters typical of Madagascar, make Nosy Hara both exceptional and immediately recognisable. Located to the north-west of Madagascar, the island is a protected area due to its incredible biodiversity. It is a veritable open-air aquarium inhabited by around 280 marine species. The rocky columns edged with gorgeous white-sand and pebble beaches fading into shades of deep blue make an idyllic place cut off from the world. This is an ideal location for snorkelling.

DAY 8. Thu 9 January 2025 **NOSY KOMBA & NOSY TANIKELY**

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During our cruise, our ship will stop in Nosy Komba, otherwise known as "lemur island". Not far from the Madagascar mainland, this volcanic island shaped like a gigantic turtle shell is covered in dense tropical rainforest. This vegetation is home to amusing black lemurs – furry orange-brown and black creatures that are surprisingly agile and call to each other from amongst the trees. The many small beaches and the emeraldcoloured water make Nosy Komba a natural gem that only a select few visit.

In the heart of the Nosy Be archipelago, discover Nosy Tanikely. nicknamed the "island of little earth." In addition to a magnificent white sand beach bordering a lagoon of crystalclear waters, the island, which is uninhabited, has exceptional marine and terrestrial biodiversity. Thanks to this, the area has been classified as a "marine and coastal protected area" since 2010. It is a perfect spot for swimming and snorkelling. Hiking fans won't be left out either: a stunning walk that climbs to the summit of the island will enable them to discover the old lighthouse built at the beginning of the 20th century and enjoy superb views over the ocean and surrounding islands.

B L D DAY 9. Fri 10 January 2025 MAJUNGA

A lively and cosmopolitan town on the west coast of Madagascar, Majunga, will be a port of call rich in discoveries. The former capital of the Sakalava kingdom, then a significant interchange due to its prime position between Africa and the Middle East, the city displays an interesting cultural patchwork. Also renowned for its outstanding natural sites, this port of call will provide you with the opportunity to discover Ankarafantsika National Park, home to many endemic animal and plant species, or the Cirque Rouge, immense red sandstone formations classified as national heritage.

DAY 10. Sat 11 January 2025 AT SEA

During our journey at sea, make the most of the many services and activities on board. Take a moment of relaxation or be tempted by the swimming pool and outer deck. Enjoy the conferences or shows on board or do some shopping in the boutique.

DAY 11. Sun 12 January 2025 **BELO SUR MER**

In the south west of the Menabe Region, in the district of Morondava, you will marvel at the picturesque beauty of Belo sur Mer. This peninsula edged with mangroves alternates fine sandy beaches with rocks plunging into a sea. This fishing village is renowned for its Dhows, the traditional sailing boats of Madagascar, which are built in situ, in the local artisanal boatvard.

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DAY 12 & DAY 13. Mon 13 & Tue 14 January 2025 B L D TOLIARA & SARODRANO

Located to the south-west of the island of Madagascar, near the mouth of the River Onilahy, Toliara is a port town that opens onto the Mozambique Channel. Inhabited for several centuries, becoming prosperous during the colonial period in the 19th century, Toliara is a cheerful town with unspoilt nature and exceptional flora that will certainly appeal to fans of botany.

Sarodrano is a small village in the south-west of Madagascar in the province of Atsimo-Andrefana, at the mouth of the Onilahy River. This village of Vezo fishermen possesses the authentic and unspoiled charm of remote places. You will be surprised by the dexterity with which these "nomads of the sea" steer their outrigger canoes to fish or keep up their ancestral traditions like seaweed cultivation.

DAY 14. Wed 15 January 2025 NOSY VE

Five kilometres out to sea from the Malagasy village of Anakao, Nosy Ve is an unspoilt paradise of exceptional wild beauty. Located on a two-kilometre (1.2 miles) long coral bank, this island is unique in that it is home to a colony of endemic birds commonly called red-tailed tropicbird. This nature reserve, a nesting site for rare birds, is unique because it is this species' only reproduction site. The duckboards installed on the island will enable you to observe the birds hidden from view under the forest of Madagascar jewel. This Eden dotted with natural pools is also a setting for coral, fish and sea turtles you can discover while snorkelling.

DAY 15 & DAY 16. Thu 16 & Fri 17 January 2025 B L D AT SEA

During our journey at sea, make the most of the many services and activities on board. Take a moment of relaxation or be tempted by the swimming pool and outer deck. Enjoy the conferences or shows on board or do some shopping in the boutique. This journey without a port of call will also be an opportunity to enjoy the conferences or shows proposed on board or to do some shopping in the boutique or to meet the PONANT photographers in their dedicated space.

DAY 17. Sat 18 January 2025 POINTE DES GALETS

At the end of the 19th century, the construction of the port of Pointe des Galets lasted seven years, with the town called Le Port emerging in its wake. You'll also hear the name "Port-Réunion" used to designate the Pointe des Galets, which is the main port on the island of La Réunion. In fact, it is the only port in France that has five functions: naval base, passenger terminal, commercial port, fishing port and marina. Here you'll be able to discover the former house of the Réunion Railway and Port Company (1878), its marine cemetery and its teeming covered market.

DAY 18. Sun 19 January 2025 PORT LOUIS – DISEMBARK SHIP

On the north-west coast of Mauritius, discover Port Louis, the country's multicultural capital. Constantly in movement, the city, which was once a port of call on the route to India, is home to many cultural and historic treasures. In addition to the city's market where you will be able to discover all the local flavours and many handicrafts, make sure that you visit Fort Adelaide. Nestling on the heights of Port Louis, this citadel built in the 16th century, classified as a national heritage monument, offers sumptuous views over the surroundings. Not far from there, the Pamplemousse Botanical Garden will reveal to you its countless plant species, coming from all four corners of the world.

DAY 19. Mon 20 January 2025 PORT LOUIS

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Today we will enjoy a full day to explore Port Louis. Take the time to make the most of the local attractions or simply relax.

DAY 20. Tue 21 January 2025 PORT LOUIS – IN TRANSIT

This morning we will enjoy breakfast before transferring to the airport for our journey home.

DAY 21. Wed 22 January 2025

IN TRANSIT

We continue our journey back to Australia.

DAY 22. Thu 23 January 2025 ARRIVE AUSTRALIA – HOME PORT

Today we arrive back in Australia and fly to our Home Port. Our Tour Host will travel to Mackay and bid you farewell in transit or on arrival in Mackay.


Grill restaurant






Deluxe Stateroom | Deck 3

Please also attach a copy of your photo ID or the photo page of your passport (for international travel) Bookings are subject to auto cancel after 7 days if the deposit and Booking & Medical Form is not received.

A partial payment of \$5,000pp is due 12th January 2024. Final payment is due no later than 4th October 2024. Failure to make payment prior to this date may result in your booking being cancelled and your deposit forfeited. If your reservation is made after this date, full payment is required at time of booking.

Holiday Pricing:

The package price is per person based on twin share accommodation and subject to a minimum number of passengers booked. Should minimum numbers not be met, we reserve the right to withdraw the departure prior to final payment date and a refund of your paid deposit will be offered.
