

Antarctic Peninsula

The Antarctic Peninsula is one of the most breathtaking and accessible regions of Antarctica, offering a dramatic introduction to the White Continent. Stretching northwards toward South America, this icy finger of land is renowned for its towering glaciers, jagged mountain ranges, and surreal seascapes dotted with icebergs of every shape and size. Its unique geography and relatively milder climate compared to the rest of Antarctica make it a haven for an incredible array of wildlife and a prime destination for expedition cruises.

The peninsula teems with life during the austral summer months, when the sea ice recedes and the land becomes accessible. Visitors can witness vast colonies of penguins, including gentoo, Adélie, and chinstrap species, as well as elephant seals and fur seals basking along the shores. The surrounding waters host an abundance of marine life, with humpback, minke, and orca whales frequently seen feeding in the nutrient-rich Southern Ocean.

For bird enthusiasts, the skies are alive with seabirds such as skuas, petrels, and albatrosses.

Beyond its wildlife, the Antarctic Peninsula is steeped in history. Early explorers like Roald Amundsen and Ernest Shackleton navigated these icy waters, leaving behind tales of courage and endurance. Today, remnants of historic research stations and whaling outposts stand as a reminder of humankind's past interactions with this remote environment.

Modern travellers to the Antarctic Peninsula explore via zodiac cruises, landings on snow-covered shores, or kayaking excursions through iceberg-filled bays. The sense of isolation and pristine beauty is unmatched, with endless opportunities for photography and quiet reflection. Whether standing before towering ice cliffs, watching a penguin colony in full swing, or cruising alongside a breaching whale, the Antarctic Peninsula offers a once-in-a-lifetime encounter with the last great wilderness on Earth.

Zodiac adventures & shore landings

When travelling to Antarctica with PONANT, one of the highlights of your expedition will be the Zodiac adventures and shore landings that bring you closer than ever to the White Continent's untamed beauty. These small, inflatable craft are the gateway between ship and shore, designed for navigating icy waters, weaving through ice floes, and reaching remote landing sites that large vessels simply cannot access.

Be prepared for multiple outings each day, depending on weather and ice conditions. Flexibility is essential, Antarctica is unpredictable, and the expedition team will adjust the schedule to make the most of each opportunity. One morning, you may glide silently between towering icebergs, their blue hues glowing in the sunlight, while in the afternoon you could step ashore to wander among colonies of penguins or admire elephant seals basking on a beach. Each landing is carefully selected by the experienced naturalist guides to showcase the unique landscapes and wildlife of the region.

Safety and comfort are priorities. Before your first excursion, the team will conduct a detailed briefing

on Zodiac operations, boarding procedures and environmental guidelines to ensure minimal impact on this pristine ecosystem. Guests are provided with a waterproof parka and waterproof boots on board, however it is vital to bring warm, layered clothing, waterproof pants, a hat & gloves to stay dry and comfortable. Landings often involve stepping into shallow water or onto uneven, rocky ground, so good mobility and a sense of adventure are important.

What can you expect once you are ashore? Prepare yourself for a true immersion in Antarctica's raw wilderness. You may find yourself standing in awe at the foot of a glacier, surrounded by seabirds wheeling overhead, or watching curious penguins waddle close. There are moments of pure silence, broken only by the cracking of ice or the distant call of wildlife, that create memories to last a lifetime.

Every Zodiac excursion with PONANT is an invitation to adventure, unpredictable, thrilling, and utterly unforgettable.

By preparing with the right gear, an open mind, and a spirit of discovery, you'll be ready to embrace the very essence of Antarctic exploration.

Your Antarctic discovery awaits

Drake Passage

If there is one place, one sea, one passage that visitors, scientists, and sailors respect in the Antarctic, it is the Drake Passage. Lying at the latitude where the famous Furious Fifties are prevalent, between Cape Horn and the South Shetland Islands, it is the shortest way to reach the Antarctic. Seasoned travellers will tell you that you have to earn the right to see the White Continent.

The “Antarctic Convergence” zone, where the northward-flowing Antarctic waters meet the warmer equatorial waters, is home to a rich variety of marine wildlife. Don’t forget to look up in order to spot elegant albatrosses and Cape petrels as they play on the wind around your ship. The waters below often reveal whales breaching or dolphins riding the waves, adding to the drama of the crossing. Though it can be unpredictable, many days the passage offers calmer conditions, often referred to as the “Drake Lake.” For adventurers, whether wild or calm, traversing the Drake Passage is a rite of passage and an unforgettable part of the Antarctic experience.

Port Lockroy

During your cruise, your ship will call at Port Lockroy, a surprising natural harbour sitting in the heart of the Antarctic Peninsula. Discovered by the explorer Jean-Baptiste Charcot, over the years it has served as a relief and repair base for whalers and a British military base in turn and it is now a scientific research station. Today, it is considered to be the most visited site in the Antarctic, thanks to its small museum that retraces the life of the station from the 1950s onward and its souvenir shop. Do not miss your chance to stop by the world’s Southernmost post office, to write to your loved ones and share this special moment with them.

Outside the station, visitors are often delighted by a lively colony of gentoo penguins that have made their home around the buildings, providing endless photo opportunities. The station is carefully managed to balance human presence with wildlife conservation, ensuring minimal impact on the environment. A visit to Port Lockroy offers both a fascinating glimpse into Antarctic history and a chance to connect with the present-day challenges of living and working in this remote region.



Deception Island

Weddell Sea

A lengthy sail in the Weddell Sea, a labyrinth in which majestic tabletop icebergs abound, will allow you to experience an extraordinary and enchanting atmosphere enhanced by true silence. Here, the gigantic platforms of ice and the ice caps sculpt a landscape like no other, home to fur seals, penguin colonies, wandering albatrosses and giant petrels. The lords of this realm, the Weddell seals, will welcome you to their lands as the roar of their cries occasionally disturbs the tranquility of the place.

This remote and pristine environment is also steeped in history, as it was near here that Sir Ernest Shackleton's ship *Endurance* became trapped and eventually crushed by the sea ice. Scientists continue to study the Weddell Sea for its unique ecosystems and critical role in the planet's climate. To witness its vast, frozen beauty firsthand is to step into one of the most awe-inspiring natural theatres on Earth.

Deception Island

Nestling in the north of the Antarctic Peninsula, Deception Island rewards the traveller's gaze with volcanic beaches and the vestiges of its abandoned huts. This was an important whaling port for a long time and in the early 19th century it became a refuge where sailors could wait for storms or icebergs to pass. The island's greatest asset is its exceptional wildlife. Today Deception Island is home to one of the largest colonies of chinstrap penguins in the Antarctic Peninsula, as well as elephant and fur seals.

The island itself is a flooded volcanic caldera, and ships can sail directly into its interior through the narrow passage known as Neptune's Bellows. The stark contrast of black volcanic sand against the brilliant white snow creates an otherworldly landscape unlike anywhere else in Antarctica. Visitors often marvel at the island's blend of dramatic geology, rich history, and thriving wildlife colonies, making it a true highlight of any Antarctic journey.

Day 1. Friday 11 February 2028

HOME PORT - SYDNEY

Let's begin our journey as we depart our home port and fly to Sydney. Our tour host will travel from Mackay and meet us either in transit or on arrival in Sydney. Upon arrival we will make our way to our accommodation for an overnight stay.

Day 2. Saturday 12 February 2028

SYDNEY - BUENOS AIRES

Let's begin our journey as we depart Australia and fly to Buenos Aires. Upon arrival we will make our way to our accommodation and enjoy an afternoon at leisure before we enjoy a welcome dinner in Buenos Aires.

Day 3. Sunday 13 February 2028

BUENOS AIRES

Today we will enjoy a city tour of Buenos Aires. Experience the past and present of Buenos Aires, visiting neighborhoods, admiring architecture, and seeing the best attractions the city has to offer. Explore the neighbourhoods of Retiro, Palermo and Recoleta, which are full of large green spaces and beautiful French-style mansions. We will make a stop at the Recoleta Cemetery, which contains the graves of notable people including Eva Perón and a granddaughter of Napoleon. In 2013, CNN listed it among the 10 most beautiful cemeteries in the world.

Afterwards we will also visit the vibrant neighbourhood of La Boca where we will admire the colorful conventillos (tenement houses), home to Italian immigrants at the end of the 19th century as well as the picturesque street Caminito.

This evening we will indulge in local Argentinean cuisine as we enjoy dinner at a Buenos Aires Restaurant.

Day 4. Monday 14 February 2028

BUENOS AIRES - USHUAIA

After breakfast we will make our way to Buenos Aires Airport for our flight to Ushuaia, the southernmost city in the world. Capital of Argentina's Tierra del Fuego province, Ushuaia is considered the gateway to the White Continent and the South Pole. Nicknamed "El fin del mundo" by the

Argentinian people, this city at the end of the world nestles in the shelter of mountains surrounded by fertile plains that the wildlife seem to have chosen as the ultimate sanctuary.

This afternoon we will embark on one of the most spectacular journeys as we board our ship and set sail for the white continent.

Day 5 & 6. Tuesday 15 & Wednesday 16 February 2028

B L D DRAKE PASSAGE

As we wake this morning we will find ourselves in the middle of the Drake Passage. We will have time to familiarise ourselves with our ship and deepen our knowledge of the Antarctic. The Expedition Leader will first present the IAATO rules of conduct that must be observed during landings in the region and will explain everything we need to know about the zodiac outings. Lectures about the history and wildlife of the Antarctic will be an opportunity for us to learn more about this magical region, where every cruise is a unique experience. From the ship's bridge, we will experience exceptional sailing moments before joining the naturalist-guides on our ship's exterior decks to look out for albatrosses, cape petrels, and other seabirds flying over the Drake Passage.

Day 7-11. Thursday 17 - Monday 21 February 2028

B L D ANTARCTIC PENINSULA

Succumb to the magic of a place unlike any other. To this day, the mythical Antarctic Peninsula still holds real fascination and promises its visitors unforgettable moments. Throughout your adventure in this icy realm, we will find ourselves in the heart of a spectacular decor in subtle shades of blue and white, surrounded by exceptional wildlife. Penguins, humpback whales, seals and giant petrels are at home here, as are elephant seals, fur seals, Antarctic minke whales and orcas. Depending on which sites we will be lucky enough to visit, we may get the chance to observe them and share with them the beauty of these extreme parts .

Each day, based on ice conditions, the Captain and the Expedition Leader will suggest Zodiac outings or landings to discover the infinite riches of the Antarctic Peninsula. Glaciers, ice floe, tabletop icebergs, mountain peaks that plunge straight into the sea, volcanic beaches, research stations,

enchanting bays and vestiges of the whaling industry: these are the faces of the Antarctic that will likely reveal themselves to us, in a hushed and surreal atmosphere.

We will sail in the wake of great Antarctic explorers who, from the 19th century, set out to conquer these remote and uninhabited lands.

Day 12&13. Tuesday 22 & Wednesday 23 February 2028 B L D
DRAKE PASSAGE

If there is one place, one sea, one waterway dreaded by tourists, researchers and hardened seafarers alike, it is undoubtedly Drake Passage. Situated at the latitude of the infamous Furious Fifties winds, between Cape Horn and the South Shetland Islands, it is the shortest route to connect Antarctica to South America.

Seasoned navigators will tell you that you must earn your visit to the White Continent! As the Antarctic convergence zone where cold currents rising up from the South Pole meet warmer equatorial water masses, Drake Passage harbours a very diverse marine fauna. Don't forget to look to the sky to catch a glimpse of elegant albatross and Cape petrels, playfully floating about in the wind around the ship.

Day 14. Thursday 24 February 2028 B D
USHUAIA - BUENOS AIRES

This morning we will arrive back in Ushuaia as our Antarctic journey comes to an end. We will disembark the ship and make our way to the airport for our flight back to Australia via Buenos Aires.

On arrival in Buenos Aires we will transfer from the airport to our accommodation for our overnight stay. Tonight we take in a spectacular treat as we enjoy our Farewell Dinner, featuring a traditional Tango Show.

Day 15. Friday 25 February 2028
DEPART BUENOS AIRES

ARRIVE AUSTRALIA - HOME PORT





Payment Schedule, Booking & Medical Form

- **INTERIM PAYMENT** of \$10,000pp is required by 01JUN27
- **INTERIM PAYMENT** of \$5,000pp is required by 01AUG27
- **FINAL PAYMENT** is due by 10DEC27

Failure to make payments as per the schedule may result in your booking being cancelled and your deposit forfeited. If your reservation is made after these dates, full payment of any funds already due is required at time of booking.

You are also required to complete a Hosted Journeys Booking & Medical Form and return it to your Travel Consultant. Please also attach a copy of your photo ID or the photo page of your passport (for international travel) Bookings are subject to auto cancel after 7 days if the deposit and Booking & Medical Form is not received.

Holiday Pricing:

The package price is per person based on twin share accommodation and subject to a minimum number of passengers booked. Should minimum numbers not be met, we reserve the right to withdraw the departure prior to final payment date and a refund of your paid deposit will be offered. Alternatively the tour will proceed as planned however the Tour Host may not travel with the group. Your holiday pricing may increase if minimum numbers are not met.

Hosted Journeys reserves the right to modify program itineraries, included sightseeing and substitute accommodations and transportation at any time due to unforeseen circumstances. In such circumstances, we will do our best to supply comparable services, accommodations and itineraries, and there shall be no refund in this situation.

Currency Adjustment

Deposits secure your reservation but do not guarantee the final price. Due to ongoing currency fluctuations, all prices remain subject to change until final payment is received. Significant movements in the value of the Australian dollar may result in a repricing of your holiday.

Special Requests:
